## The 88<sup>th</sup> annual Men's St. Lawrence Golf Tournament

## Hosted at the Mississippi Golf Course Friday July 24 and Saturday July 25

Ten man teams, representing the Amherstview, Gananoque, Garrison, Cataraqui, Perth, Smiths Falls, Brockville, Prescott, Cornwall, Potsdam and Massena met at the Mississippi Golf Club for the 88<sup>th</sup> playing of the St. Lawrence Association Golf Tournament. The teams are comprised of 1 junior player, 1 senior player (55 and over), 2 players over the age of 40 and 6 other players.

The tournament counts the best 8 of 10 gross scores per day. There is also a low medallist for the 2 days, low medallist each day, low senior for the 2 days and low junior for the 2 days.

All competitors play from the blue tees, except for the senior players who play from the white tees. The skins game competition is for every participant, regardless of what tees they play from.
